RE: Fall CME 2011

The CEPCP is currently preparing the Fall CME. The focus of the training will be on the new provincial medical directives. At this time, the directives have not been finalized, but are available in a “draft” format.

In anticipation of the training, we have posted copies of the complete “draft” directives for both ACP and PCP on our website. They can be found at: http://www.cepcp.ca/main/paramedic_cmecurrent.html and can be downloaded in a pdf format either as a single document or individual directives. NOTE – not all auxiliary directives will apply to your practice. Under the review materials tabs, you can access the individual directives as a pdf, but also video clips discussing the specific directives. On the far right on that screen, there are practice quiz questions to help prepare you for the testing that will take place during the CME. We have also created a video presentation specifically addressing the new formatting of the directives and the conventions used and the content of the preamble to the directives. It would be beneficial to review these prior to attending your CME.

The format of the CME may be anything from short presentations to table top discussions, to case based learning to hands on skills and scenarios. Be prepared to participate in any and all events.
